ENTRACK at the European Week of Regions and Cities | 13-15 October, Belgium, Brussels

On 13-15 October the European Week of Regions and Cities took place in Brussels. The event brought together European cities, where experts, academia, researchers and policy makers met to discuss policies, share knowledge and shape future trends.

ENTRACK participated actively in the event with both a **workshop** and a **stand**. The workshop was held in collaboration with the **PLENTY Life** project under the topic "*Small Towns, Big Energy: Citizens Shaping a Sustainable Future*". The session showcased how small towns and rural municipalities can lead Europe's fair energy transition highlighting both projects' results, presenting case studies and encouraging participants to implement similar strategies in their regions, followed by a discussion with pilot city representatives, concluding with guided audience questions on how the methodology can be replicated.
