

# **Energy Communities: The ENTRACK Project Presented** in Piano di Sorrento

Designing clean energy transition plans and having the opportunity to contribute to this important European initiative is a meaningful responsibility. These were the central themes of the public meeting held to present the ENTRACK project on **Wednesday**, **29 October**, in the Council Chamber of the Town Hall of Piano di Sorrento.

The project, co-funded by the European Commission, involves 13 partners from five European countries. The municipalities of Piano di Sorrento and Vico Equense are the main Italian representatives in this initiative. Coordinated by AISFOR srl (represented in Piano di Sorrento by project coordinator Dr. Marina Varvesi), the ENTRACK project also includes two municipalities from Greece (Topeiros and Avdira), two from Portugal (Ponte de Sor and Gavião), and two from Spain (Gombrèn and Sant Quirze de Besora), along with several partners from companies and associations in the energy sector.

### **ENTRACK Project**

The ENTRACK project aims to enhance the knowledge and capabilities of local governments in promoting a fair and equitable energy transition. This bottom-up approach originates from local territories and reflects a commitment to fostering structured and ongoing dialogue with diverse stakeholders across European municipalities and regions. Its goal is to support the co-design of a clean and socially just energy transition.

ENTRACK also seeks to identify the key factors that shape citizens' perceptions, needs, and priorities, and to generate policy recommendations that inform decision-making processes related to energy transition and the development of inclusive energy policies.
